Place of Birth: Oregon City

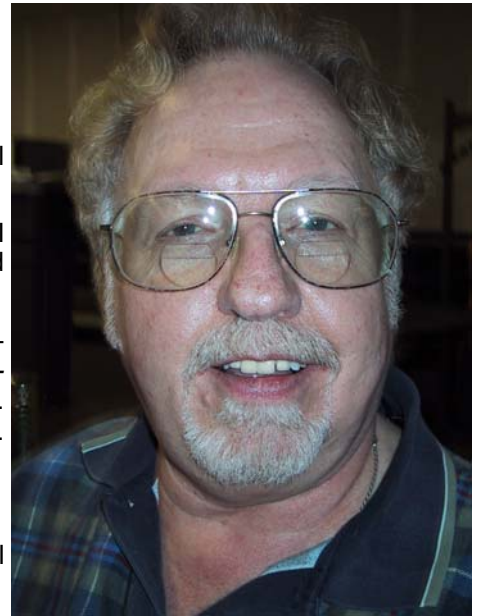
Favorite Job: Favorite and least favorite: barber—I've only had one job all my life.
